At the hospital they found a pingpong ball sized mass on the right side of his brain and had to do surgery to remove it. Waiting on an update on how it went.

*Kris - UPDATE - (Marsha Gorbitz friend from WA) still having infections in the leg/ankle she had surgery on back in July. Dr.'s are doing a 3rd surgery to remove all the hardware they put in her ankle/ leg. They believe that is what is causing her continued infections. Surgery was on 10/17, prayers for complete healing and no more complications for her.

*Sue Kelly - health concerns, prayers they will get better as they are keeping her from being able to come to church regularly.


